## **Ontario District Guidelines**

The CJCA Ontario District shall operate under the following guidelines:

- 1. The Ontario District of the Canadian J/24 Class Association will compete under CJCA Rules. CJCA Rules rely on the IJCA and ISAF rules.
- 2. Series scoring at Ontario District events will be as follows:
  - a. Eligible helmspersons will be scored towards a Worlds Qualifier position. The award given to the top helmsperson is the Genco Trophy. Eligibility is defined in the CJCA By-Laws.
  - b. Boats registered by sail number will be scored towards the Overall Ontario District Series Championship. The award given to the top boat is the Ombrelle Trophy.
  - c. The World Qualifier and Ontario District series may comprise of overlapping or separate events.
- 3. A minimum of three World Qualifying regattas are to be held each year, with first event being held no earlier than May and the last event held no later than September.
- 4. The Ontario Championship shall be contested at a single event that may or may not be a World Qualifier or Ontario Series event.
- 5. The year-end party should be held in late November. Overall series prizes and individual recognitions should be awarded then.
- No World Qualifier regattas are to be hosted on Long Weekends (Victoria Day, Canada Day, Simcoe Day, and Labour Day)
- 7. Any Ontario boat and helmsperson participating in the J/24 World Championships, North American Championships, or Canadian Championships which overlaps any World Qualifying regatta(s) shall receive YMP (average points) for that/those regatta(s) missed, for purposes of overall series results. The average of all races sailed in each series for the entire season will determine the average score.
- 8. There will be 1 drop race for every 5 completed races sailed. (e.g. -If 13 races are sailed, then there will only be 2 drop races)
- 9. Measurement certificates and a copy of both liability and damage insurance must available for presentation to race organizers at time of registration, if requested.
- 10. All helmspersons must be Racing Members of the CJCA to enter World Qualifier events.
- 11. All helmspersons must be Members of the CJCA to enter Ontario Series events.
- 12. All owners, who race onboard, must be members of the CJCA.
- 13. The Ontario class will provide 20% penalty sign in sheets, crew and sail substitution sheets for all Ontario regattas in order to help the regatta organizers.
- 14. NOR's that are e-mailed should have a link to the class' standard SI's
- 15. A fleet is defined as a yacht or sailing club with at least 3 or more J/24's. Each fleet shall appoint a Fleet Captain for purposes of voting on Ontario business. The Fleet Captains, District Governor and one CJCA executive member may vote on Ontario business.
- 16. Any dispute shall be voted upon, as soon as possible, by at least 50% of current Fleet Captains and, if a tie in the voting exists, the deciding vote shall be cast by the District Governor, otherwise, the District Governor shall not vote.
